

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)
for Scientific-Research Cooperation
between
Masarykova univerzita, Brno
Filozofická fakulta
Ústav klasických studií
Oddělení pravěké archeologie Předního východu (PANE)
(Česká Republika)
&
Università di Napoli "L' Orientale "L' Orientale"
(Republic of Italy)

The Università di Napoli "L' Orientale" (hereafter referred to as "UNIOR") of the Italian Republic, on one hand, and the Masarykova univerzita (hereafter referred to as "MU") of the Czech Republic, on the other, based on the existing *bona fide* relations and on the mutual disposition to develop and promote cooperation in the fields of culture and research, also in consideration that visiting lectures were conducted at Masaryk University by UNIOR teachers and a Czech UNIOR PhD candidate is conducting an archaeological project in the Sultanate of Oman in a cooperation with the Centre of Prehistoric Archaeology of the Near East (PANE) of Masaryk University.

The MU and the UNIOR hereafter referred to as "the parties", will perform necessary cooperation.

Section 1

The Parties will focus their attention on the promotion of cultural cooperation, research, exchange of knowledge and experiences in the following fields:

- Archaeological studies related to the archaeology of the Arabian Peninsula;
- Classical and Mediterranean Studies.

Section 2

The Parties pursue the cultural cooperation mentioned in section 1 through the following means:

- Exchange of professors, researchers and students for training and research;
- Exchange of books and bibliographic material;
- Holding conferences, lectures and educational workshops;
- Publication of scientific books and studies;
- Cooperation in research activities;
- Joint international development projects and programmes.

Section 3

The Parties will attempt to facilitate the contacts between professors, researchers and students proposed by the other party in their own country universities and research institutions.

Section 4

The Parties will nominate their representatives in a Consultative Committee, which will examine and implement the objectives of the MOU.

Section 5

In case of discrepancy in interpretation and/or execution of the MOU, the matter will be settled down by the Rector of the MU and by the Rector of UNIOR and/or through consultation in the Consultative Committee, mentioned at section 4.

Section 6

This MOU will be valid for a period of five years from the date of signature by the parties and it will be automatically extended for the same period unless one of the parties announces its will for revocation. In this case, the MOU will be terminated three months after sending the letter of revocation.

Note: The termination/expiration of the MOU will have no effect on the ongoing research and unfinished projects and the MOU provisions will be effective on the projects till they are accomplished.




Specimen Signatures of Statutory Deputies to the Rector




