Note	<p>The course is in English and attendance is compulsory.</p> <p>The cycle of seminars consists of 12 lectures (6 x 2 hours) and focuses on various people who speak endangered languages in Siberia, Russia. The lectures will present the Paleo-siberian, Uralic, Tungusic and Turkic language families, their present situation, their historical, linguistic and cultural features, sociolinguistic situation, language contacts, their connection with Mongolic people and other Asian and non-Asian languages. The expected lectures are some of the most renowned experts of Siberian Studies as Edvard Vajda (Western Washington University, USA), Elena Skribnik (Munich University, Germany), Sándor Szeverényi (Szeged University, Hungary) and Khabtagaeva Bayarma (L'Orientale).</p> <p>Evaluation: The drafting of a final report is foreseen, which for students takes the form of a short essay on interested topic.</p>
