MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

University of Napoli L'Orientale in Napoli, Italy and Jeju National University in the Republic of Korea aim to develop the academic and cultural interchange between the two institutions through mutual assistance in the areas of education, research, and other activities as:

- 1. Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students;
- 2. Exchange of faculty members;
- 3. Exchange of staffs;
- 4. Joint research activities.

The terms of such mutual assistance and necessary budget for each program and activity that is implemented under the terms of this agreement will be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both parties prior to the initiation of the particular program or activity, and such program and activity will be negotiated on an annual basis. Each institution will designate a Liaison Officer to develop and coordinate specific activities or programs.

This agreement may be revised, modified or amended by the exchange of letters between the two institutions. Such amendments, once approved by both institutions, will become part of this Agreement. The agreement may remain in force for a period of three (3) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party giving written notice to the other party no later than six (6) months before the termination date. The agreement may be extended by mutual consent of the two parties.

Two original copies of this agreement will be written in English and both parties will keep one each.

AGREEMENT FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE **BETWEEN**

JEJU NATIONAL UNIVERSITY AND University of Napoli L'Orientale

To implement exchange programs based on agreement of cooperation between University of Napoli L'Orientale in Napoli, Italy and Jeju National University in Jeju, Republic of Korea, the designated officials responsible for program administration mutually agree that:

- 1. Each university will recommend 2 exchange students in a year in undergraduate and graduate programs.
- 2. The home university will provide the host university with completed application forms. The students must have sufficient language proficiency required by the host university. And the host university may decide to accept the applicants or not.
- 3. Exchange students must be enrolled as full-time students of credit courses at their home university.
- 4. Exchange students will be exempted from paying tuition fee, entrance examination fee, admission fee at the host university.
- 5. Exchange students are required to obtain health insurance during the period of exchange to provide proof to the host university.
- 6. Exchange students may live on campus housing and need to complete the room and board license contract and submit the contract to host institution in a timely fashion, and exchange students are responsible for the accommodation cost.
- 7. The host university will evaluate and grade academic performance of exchange or study abroad students and send official transcripts to their home university.
- 8. The exchange period is up to one year. Both participants reserve the right to discontinue the study term of exchange students at any time for violation of their rules and regulations.
- 9. The memorandum may be revised or modified through jointly discussion and consent between the two sides. This arrangement becomes effective until 3 years from the date of signatures of two signatories. The period may be terminated by one of the signatories upon written notice to the other party no later than six months before the termination date.

Two original copies will be written in English and both parties will keep one each.
