Note	The course is English and attendance is compulsory. The course consists of 12 lectures (6 x 2 hours) and is aimed at gaining practice in reading Classical Mongolian texts. Classical Mongolian has been used by the Mongols since the 13th century and is still used in Inner Mongolia (China). After completing this course, students will be able to read independently and translate simple Classical Mongolian texts. They will attain the grammar of Classical Mongolian and its special linguistic features. During the course, students will learn to analyze a text in morphological terms, and will be taught phonetic transcription and transliteration. They will also learn to use the most relevant dictionaries.
	Evaluation: The drafting of a final report is foreseen, which for students takes the form of a short essay.
