Note	<p>The aim of this seminar is to introduce the students to the tradition of reading Classical and Literary Chinese-language texts in Japanese. The subject will cover both theoretical (linguistic) topics, and practical use of kanbun kundoku trained on real texts (of both Chinese and Japanese provenience). After attending this seminar, the students will know all the basic rules of kanbun kundoku, they will know the specific vocabulary used in kanbun kundoku, and they will be able to read Chinese-language texts with kunten marking.</p> <p>Contents:</p> <p>Basic introduction – basic terminology – kanbun, hakubun, kunten, kundoku, etc.; theoretical introduction to the language used for kanbun kundoku;</p> <p>Kunten – how to use the marking system to translate a Chinese text into Japanese – kaeriten, etc.;</p> <p>Practical exercises for using kunten;</p> <p>Hendoku moji – explanation with example sentences, practical exercises;</p> <p>Saidoku moji – explanation with example sentences, practical exercises;</p> <p>Okiji – example sentences, Classical Chinese texts 1 – reading of a simple text;</p> <p>Classical Chinese texts 2 – reading more advanced texts, Chinese poetry;</p> <p>Examples of Japanese kanbun texts.</p>
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
