MEMORANDUM OF COOPERATION

Between

Saint Andrew the First-Called Georgian University of the Patriarchate of Georgia

Tbilisi, Georgia

and

University of Naples L'Orientale

Naples, Italy

This memorandum of cooperation ("MoC") is made by and between Saint Andrew the First-Called Georgian University of the Patriarchate of Georgia, represented by the Rector, Professor Irakli Brachuli, and University of Naples L'Orientale, represented by the Rector prof. Roberto Tottoli. Both shall be collectively referred to as the "Parties". In the spirit of friendship and with mutual interest in cooperation, the parties agree as follows:

Article 1. Purpose of the Cooperation

The Agreement primarily concerns the activities of study and research. Both Universities may establish cooperation in any academic and research areas of their interest. The MoC promotes the implementation of collaborative and mutually beneficial projects that serve to enhance intellectual life and increase international cooperation. The Parties agree that this MoC will provide the foundation and framework for later particular projects.

Article 2. The subject of the Cooperation

The subject of this Memorandum is to set out the general framework for the cooperation between the Parties in the field of educational and scientific research activities. To implement the goals of this Memorandum, the Parties have generally agreed to cooperate (subject to further details to be elaborated later) in the following areas:

- a) Facilitating the staff and/or students of the Parties in obtaining valuable education, conducting joint research activities and publications, participating in offline and online seminars and academic meetings, delivering online/offline lectures, consulting academic staff and students, jointly evaluating research projects written by students, reviewing theses, participating in

projects, training, conferences, and other activities face-to-face or remotely via the internet, and exploring any other activities viewed to be mutually beneficial.

- b) Exchanging experience and information aiming at research and educational programs/projects.
- c) Organizing and/or attending joint events within the research and educational programs/projects.
- d) Exchange of academic staff for didactic activities, and guest lectures.
- e) Support of student exchange
- f) Participation in different grant opportunities

Article 3. Validity and Revision of the Memorandum

- 1. This MoC enters into effect on the day of its signing by the Parties, and remains valid unless terminated by either party.
- 2. The revision or alteration of this MoC is possible by the mutual written agreement. The amendment shall be the undivided part of the memorandum.
- 3. The terms of cooperation for each specific activity implemented under this MoC shall be mutually discussed and will be the subject of separate agreements.
- 4. This MoC does not impose any legal and financial obligations for the Parties'
- 5. This MoC is executed in English in 2 (two) original copies, all of which are equally valid and enforceable. Each party holds one original copy.
