











Study Opportunities for Indonesian Students at the University of Naples L'Orientale, Napoli, Italy

The University of Naples L'Orientale is expanding its international academic cooperation by offering €2,000 grants for students from Indonesia's leading universities.

Through agreements with Universitas Indonesia (UI), Universitas Diponegoro (UNDIP), Universitas Gadjah Mada (UGM), Universitas Udayana (UNUD), and Universitas Atma Jaya (UAJ), selected students will have the chance to study in Italy and experience a new academic environment. Notably, two grants are reserved for UGM students as part of a double degree MA programme in International Relations, allowing them to spend an academic year at L'Orientale.

This programme is designed to promote student mobility, encourage cultural integration, and support academic growth. Students can attend courses in various disciplines, with the credits earned in Italy transferred to their home universities. To ensure a smooth academic experience, a learning agreement will outline the courses taken at L'Orientale and their corresponding credits upon the student's return.

Applicants must demonstrate a strong motivation to study in Italy and commit to regular class attendance. A B2 level of English is required, while basic knowledge of Italian is recommended but not mandatory.

Students interested in applying should submit their applications to the international offices of their respective universities. Each university's international office is responsible for nominating candidates, with the nomination process closing at the end of April 2025.

This initiative represents more than just a study opportunity, it reflects the growing partnership between Italy and Indonesia. By collaborating with UI, UNDIP, UGM, UNUD, and UAJ, L'Orientale strengthens its role as a cultural and academic bridge between Europe and Southeast Asia, fostering a globally connected academic community that benefits students and researchers alike.

Students exchange program with University of Naples L'Orientale, Napoli, Italy

Period of study: 1st semester of the academic year 2025-2026

(September 2025-February 2026)

Expected arrival in Italy: 20 September, 2025

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Motivation: Candidates must demonstrate a strong motivation to study at L'Orientale and attend regular classes of any topic.

- 2. Language Skills: A B2 level of English is required. Basic knowledge of Italian is recommended but not mandatory.
- 3. Credit Transfer: Students must pass exams in Italy to transfer credits to their home university. This process follows a learning agreement that specifies the courses to be taken at "L'Orientale" and their equivalent credits upon returning to their home institution.
- 4. Regular enrolment in the designated Universities at BA or MA level.

Application Process:

- 1. Applications must be submitted to the international offices of the respective universities indicating the courses to attend and attaching the transcript of academic records, a motivation letter and proof of the English level requirements.
- 2. The international offices of each university will nominate candidates, with nominations due by the end of April.
