






The Logic of Community in *Kyo-machiya* Neighborhoods: The Coexistence of People, Objects, Space and Its Transformation

Kyoto is a large city with a population of 1.47 million, yet it is a rare city in Japan where traditional rituals and culture, based on over 1,200 years of history, continue to thrive in modern life. This presentation will introduce the wisdom and principles underlying the coexistence of diverse people through the interconnection of humans, objects, and space in the community of *Kyo-machiya*, traditional wooden townhouses. Specific examples will be presented, and the recent changes and disappearance of these communities will be reported to share concerns about their future.
